

1. Open the Google homepage at <u>www.google.co.uk</u> and click on "Search Settings"



Tip This guide assumes that you have a Gmail account.

2. The "Search settings" page will open. Scroll down to the "Safe Search Filtering" section and click on the "Use strict filtering (Filter both explicit text and explicit images)" -



next **click** on "Lock SafeSearch" to open the web page below, **sign in** by typing your Gmail email address and password as shown – then **click** on the "Sign in" button
